The Pastor's Corner

Easter is almost here! During this time, many people have some fun with eggs, candy, and bunnies. But I hope each of us as believers also take time to celebrate Christ's Resurrection this Easter! The Resurrection is the heart of the Christian Gospel.

C.S Lewis, in his book, Miracles, put it this way:

"The Resurrection is the central theme in every Christian sermon reported in the Acts. The Resurrection and its consequences were the "gospel" or good news which the Christians brought: what we call the "gospels," the narratives of our Lord's life and death, were composed later for the benefit of those who had already accepted the *gospel*. They were in no sense the basis of Christianity: they were written for those already converted. The miracle of the Resurrection, and the theology of that miracle, comes first; the biography comes later as a comment on it.

Nothing could be more unhistorical than to pick out selected sayings of Christ from the gospels and to regard those as the datum [starting point] and the rest of the New Testament as a construction upon it. The first fact in the history of Christendom is a number of people who say they have seen the Resurrection."

In the Bible, in 1 Corinthians 15, Paul said,

12 But tell me this—since we preach that Christ rose from the dead, why are some of you saying there will be no resurrection of the dead? 13 For if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised either. 14 And if Christ has not been raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your faith is useless. 15 And we apostles would all be lying about God—for we have said

that God raised Christ from the grave. But that can't be true if there is no resurrection of the dead. ¹⁶ And if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised. ¹⁷ And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins. ¹⁸ In that case, all who have died believing in Christ are lost! ¹⁹ And if our hope in Christ is only for this life, we are more to be pitied than anyone in the world. 1 Corinthians 15:12-19 (NLT)

If the resurrection isn't true, then there's no use living the Christian life!

Thankfully, the resurrection is true! Paul continued his message by saying,

20 But in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead. He is the first of a great harvest of all who have died. 21 So you see, just as death came into the world through a man, now the resurrection from the dead has begun through another man. 22 Just as everyone dies because we all belong to Adam, everyone who belongs to Christ will be given new life. 1 Corinthians 15:20-22 (NLT)

Belief in the resurrection of Christ - it's the center of the Gospel message. It's our reason for hope. It's why we meet together as a church. *Christ is Risen. He is Risen, Indeed!*

Ratner Companies, and The Home Depot.


