The Pastor's Corner

I once read a devotional that included the following passage from the book of 2 Samuel. It tells us about some of King David's mightiest warriors,

8 These are the names of David's mightiest warriors. The first was Jashobeam the Hacmonite, who was leader of the Three —the three mightiest warriors among David's men. He once used his spear to kill 800 enemy warriors in a single battle. ⁹ Next in rank among the Three was Eleazar son of Dodai, a descendant of Ahoah. Once Eleazar and David stood together against the Philistines when the entire Israelite army had fled. 10 He killed Philistines until his hand was too tired to lift his sword, and the LORD gave him a great victory that day. The rest of the army did not return until it was time to collect the plunder! 11 Next in rank was Shammah son of Agee from Harar. One time the Philistines gathered at Lehi and attacked the Israelites in a field full of lentils. The Israelite army fled, ¹² but Shammah held his ground in the middle of the field and beat back the Philistines. So the LORD brought about a great victory. 2 Sam 23:8-12 (NLT)

Here's what happened. Around 1000 BC, King David organized 30 of his best soldiers as an elite force. It was a group of mighty men, people who were excellent at their jobs and fiercely loyal to their king. Three of these thirty were further recognized as the most courageous of all the soldiers in the armies of Israel.

The second man mentioned in this group went by the name of Eleazar. Scripture says that once the Israelites were fighting the Philistines, and the entire army of Israel fled from the battle--everyone except David and Eleazar. Eleazar stood with King David and fought until he was so tired, he could no longer lift up his sword...and scripture says the Lord gave Israel a great victory that day, and that the rest of the army did not return until it was time to collect the plunder.

Here's the point: It takes great courage to keep fighting when others are giving up around you. It takes great courage to keep fighting for Christ, even when you are outnumbered. But most importantly, it takes great humility to keep fighting when the rest of the army only comes back in time to pick up your plunder.

It's easy for people in Christian service to become weary. It's easy to give up. And it's even easier to get bitter when it seems that you're always the one doing the work, and others just come to take the plunder.

But God called us to fight, and if He called us to fight, then He'll give us the strength to finish the job. Don't give up. David and Eleazar didn't give up until the battle was won...and the only way two people can defeat an entire army is if their strength is from God and not from themselves.


