The Pastor's Corner

A while back I was watching television, and I saw a commercial for Farmers Insurance Company. In the background of the commercial, there was this music, with the lyrics, "Hallelujah! Jubilation! Shout it up and down the mountain. I'm no longer like before, I've been restored." I enjoyed the song, and I really liked the commercial, because it was honest!

The purpose of insurance is restoration. That's it! Insurance, if working correctly, involves a number of people each giving a little, so if something happens to one of them, the pooled funds can be used to attempt to put the person affected back to the way he/she was before the incident occurred. That's how insurance is supposed to work.

The commercial simply told the truth about what insurance is designed to do. This wasn't an advertisement with agents materializing out of nowhere. It didn't promise hundreds of dollars of savings. And it didn't use talking ducks, reptiles, or pricing guns. It was simply a commercial explaining what insurance does... it restores us to the place we were before a terrible event happened.

Now if we think about this from a spiritual point of view, Christ was the one who performed the ultimate restoration. Because of the Fall, we were separated from our relationship to God. But Christ paid the price for us. He restored our relationship with our Heavenly Father. So we no longer have to live the way we did before, because we've been restored. Paul put it this way in 1 Corinthians 6:9-11:

Those who indulge in sexual sin, or who worship idols, or commit adultery, or are male prostitutes, or practice homosexuality, 10 or are thieves, or greedy people, or drunkards, or are abusive, or cheat people—none of these will inherit the Kingdom of

God. 11 Some of you were once like that. But you were cleansed; you were made holy; you were made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 (NLT)

Jesus has restored our relationship with God. We don't have to live in the sin that we had before. That's certainly a reason to sing praises!

Now, with a little help from some search engines and the internet, I was able to find the rest of the song from the background of the commercial. The song is called "I've been Restored" by a guy named Bob Pyle. The first verse does talk about a car that had fallen apart and was restored. But in the bridge, the songwriter starts talking about himself, he says,

"Looking backwards to a time, of delusion and selfpride, I'm surprised, that I made it through the troubled times of life. Now Hallelujah, Adoration, pure as water from the fountain, that's been sent down by the Lord, I've been restored....Reformation, Jubilation, shout it all across the nation, I'm no longer like before, I've been restored."

God does the ultimate restoration. We no longer need to live controlled by sin. The Apostle Paul said that we were once sinners... but we were cleansed, we were made right. How? By calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and by the Spirit of God. Jesus has restored our relationship with God, and the Holy Spirit helps us to continually be the people He has called us to be. Jesus paid the ultimate premium, to provide us with the greatest insurance, against the worst thing that could ever possibly happen to us.
