Pastor's Corner

There are passages in scripture that most of us know. For example, you're probably familiar with Proverbs 3:5-6, in which Solomon says,

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. **6** Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. (Prov 3:5-6 NLT)

A lot of us memorized this passage as a child. Perhaps at Sunday School, or VBS.

However, whenever there is a well know passage in a scripture text, it's easy to forget about the passages surrounding it.

In this case, look at Proverbs 3:7, here Solomon says,

7 Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the LORD and turn away from evil. Prov 3:5-7 (NLT)

So many times in life...just when we think we've got it all figured out – that's the precise moment we fall flat on our face. Our own wisdom too often lets us down!

For example, during this time - during the beginning of a new year, people often look back upon the past year, and they think about changes they would like to make.

Even spiritually, we often do this. We say, "I'm going to read my Bible more." Or, "I'm going to pray more", or "I'm going to invite more people to church."

We make resolutions just like the world makes resolutions. And we think if we can just plan and figure it out, we can follow through.

But the problem is what? It's tricky, because some things do take time and effort. Bible Study takes time and effort. Prayer takes time and effort. Loving people, and witnessing to them, it takes time and effort. That's part of it.

BUT, there's more to it. Unless God truly changes our hearts, trying to change on our own just isn't going to last.

C.S. Lewis, in Mere Christianity, he put it this way, he said,

"Thus, in one sense, the road back to God is a road of moral effort, of trying harder and harder. But in another sense it is not trying that is ever going to bring us home. All this trying leads up to the vital moment at which we turn to God and say, 'You must do this. I can't."

Maybe there's something in your life you know you need to change. You haven't been able to change. Why not start at the beginning...ask God to change your heart. Say, "God, I know what you want me to do. Give me the strength to do it. I can't make this change without You." -Pastor Jim.
