We've been talking about the passages that surround well-known scriptures. Last month, we talked about Proverbs 3:7. Today, I'd like us to look at another passage, Hebrew 4:13.

Most of us know Hebrews 4:12,

God's word is living and active. It is sharper than any two-edged sword...

But most of us don't know the next verse, Hebrews 4:13, by heart...

No creature can hide from God. Everything is uncovered and exposed for him to see. We must answer to him.

The truth is, we can't hide things forever. I remember when I was really young, my parents took me and my sister to a *Harlem Globetrotters* basketball game. My dad bought us a souvenir mini *Globetrotter's* basketball...the ones with the red, white, and blue colors.

When we got back home, my father and I were playing with the basketball, reenacting the Globetrotters' routine at our house. But mom saw us, and she yelled at us to put it away, to not play ball in the house. So we put it up.

But one day...it was rainy outside...and mom was still at work...so dad and I had the opportunity to practice our *Globetrotters'* routine in the living room. All went well...until I missed a pass...and the ball sailed onto the coffee table and decapitated one of my mother's collectable blue glass swans.

We surveyed the damage and cleaned up the broken glass. It appeared to be a pretty clean break, and mom wasn't home yet, so we quickly took the swan into the garage and superglued the it back together. We had it sitting in the vice, and we were going to leave it clamped as long as we could until just before she got home.

When we heard her car pulling up, we quickly and carefully took the swan out of the vice, put it back on the coffee table. Mom came in...we held our breath for a few moments...but she was none the wiser to what we had done. WE THOUGHT WE HAD GOTTEN AWAY WITH IT.

Until Easter came around a year later...and mom was dusting off the coffee table...and the swan's repaired head fell off.

She looked right at me...and I'm like, "DAD DID IT"...

The bottom line is, our sin does find us out. A couple of years ago we went to a Youth Service at Jeter's Chapel. One of the youth from their church spoke. He talked about his grandmother, and how, whenever he got in trouble, his grandmother would always find out about it. He said, "GRANDMA KNOWS!!".

Just like our mothers and grandmothers. God knows when we sin. We can't hide it from him. So it's best to confess and repent as early as we can. Pastor Jim.
