The Pastor's Corner

In Ephesians chapter 4, the apostle Paul exhorts us as believers to maintain unity. We can read his words from verses 1-6,

¹ Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. ² Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. ³ Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. ⁴ For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future. ⁵ There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ and one God and Father, who is over all and in all and living through all. Eph 4:1-6 (NLT)

But when do we keep unity, and at what point do we have to separate? Generally, the church has separated doctrine into three areas, and this helps us to understand when we need to separate, and when we need to just shake hands and "agree to disagree".

- First, there is primary doctrine. These are things of utmost importance. Things like the Deity of Christ, the Virgin Birth, and the Truth of the Resurrection. These are things that we should not compromise. Believers have even been willing to die over such things.
- Next, we have secondary doctrine. Churches and denominations often distinguish themselves by secondary doctrines. An example of a secondary doctrine would be the role of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Churches may disagree over a secondary doctrine, and yet they are still able to work together around primary doctrines.
- Lastly, we have what is called tertiary doctrine. People in the same church can disagree over tertiary doctrines. Examples of this include what version of scripture is read, or what system of eschatology one believes.

It's okay for believers, even ones in the same church, to disagree over tertiary doctrine. Even though we may have these disagreements, this should not decrease the fellowship that we have with one another. May we continue, as Paul said, "to make every effort to keep ourselves united, making allowance for each other's faults."
