

#### Pastor's Corner

For the last couple of months, we've been looking at the "forgotten" scripture passages of the Bible. By "forgotten", we are talking about passages that occur in the context, or near other, more "popular" passages.

We've already looked at Hebrews 4:12 and Proverbs 3:7. But for this month, we're going to talk about a passage that follows one of the most popular passages in scripture. Our passage for this month is going to be John 3:17.

Almost all of us know John 3:16. It's probably the first memory verse most of us learned.

16 "For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (NLT)

But the next passage is often forgotten. In John 3:17, we read the following words,

17 God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. John 3:17 (NLT)

The first time Christ came, his primary purpose was to bring lost people back into a right relationship with God. There is coming a day, however, when Christ will come back to judge. In Matthew 25 Christ talks about coming back in Glory and sitting upon a judgment throne. So how does this work out in our lives? What does it mean for us today?

First, we need to realize that unsaved people are often going to act like unsaved people! They may use course language. They might be selfish. They might be greedy. They might not always treat others fairly.

But these are the people that we are called to reach. God called us to reach these people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We can't expect unsaved sinners to act like saints! We can't let the behavior or customs of unsaved people scare us away from loving them, and from trying to reach them with the truth of the Gospel!

However, once people accept the Christ, and the Holy Spirit enters their lives...He convicts them when they sin. We SHOULD expect people who claim to know Jesus, we should expect people like this to live holy lives.

As part of a church body, we're called to encourage each other to live holy lives. This can be a tough thing. But as Christians, this is part of our witness. In 1 Thessalonians Paul was talking to the believers of the church at Thessalonica, and in chapter 5, Paul talks about the Lord's return. And he specifically mentions what believers should be doing as they wait for Christ to come back. Paul wrote,

11 So encourage each other and build each other up, just as you are already doing. 1 Thess 5:11 (NLT)

This is what we're to be doing as well.




### **BABY/CHILD DEDICATION**


