This month I'd like to talk about 3 big decisions in the lives of every believer.

The first decision is a SALVATION decision. This is where we accept Christ as Savior & Lord. A lot people use the Romans Road to discuss salvation. Basically,

Romans 3:23 tells us that we are all sinners Romans 6:23 tells us the wages of sin is death Romans 5:8 says that Jesus died for us Romans 10:9 says if we confess that Jesus is Lord and believe that God raised Him from the dead, we will be sayed.

That is the first decision a person makes...it's literally HOW they become a Christian. The salvation decision.



The next major decision is BAPTISM. In the Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus says,

Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. ²⁰Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

Baptism does not save us, but it's the FIRST step of obedience for a believer, once they have accepted Christ as their savior. Baptism is a public declaration of faith in Jesus Christ. It symbolizes the believer's identification with Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. It's a outward PICTURE of what

already has happened in a person's heart when they accepted Jesus.

For example...when the person is put under the water...that's a picture of death...if they were held there, they would die. But the person is brought back up out of the water...that's a picture of them being risen with Christ. Baptism is a kind of testimony...where we are showing the world that we have a new relationship with Christ.

The Third major decision that a Christian usually makes regards CHURCH MEMBERSHIP. Church membership is a formal association with a local church community. It involves committing to a specific congregation, participating in its activities, and often agreeing to its doctrinal beliefs and practices.

Our church requires that church members be baptized. Often, folks will make a decision to be baptized and join the church at the same time. And so, after the baptism, I will present their name before the church, saying...MR. SOANDSO has accepted Christ, been baptized, and would like to unite with us...all in favor say AMEN! And when the congregation says, "Amen", they are voting the person into fellowship.

Sometimes folks chose to get baptized first...and then later, after they are little older, they decide to commit to becoming a church member. So they accept Jesus, the come forward and get baptized...and then a few years down the road, they come forward a join the church.

It's important to remember that these are 3 distinct decisions. Salvation (accepting Jesus), baptism, and church membership. So don't get them confused. Baptism doesn't automatically save a person (their sins aren't washed away in that water...only Jesus blood paid the price for our sins). Just as being baptized doesn't automatically make one a church member...A person must commit to a church and be accepted into fellowship.


